2024 VENDOR POLICY AGREEMENT

The Kincardine Saturday Farmer's Market (KSFM) has been operating since 2006. The purpose of the market is to promote local food and local producers and to make connections between customers and products in our own area.

The vendors will work together to meet these goals.

Vendors will market produce that is at least **75%** locally-produced from a radius of **100km** from the Kincardine Saturday Farmer's Market.

Vendors agree to arrive early to set up and be ready to go by **9am**. Please notify the KSFM manager if you will be absent.

All vendors must work together to ensure that the market atmosphere is positive and conflict free. Please acquaint

yourself with other vendor's products and encourage your customers to visit other booths if they are looking for specific products.

This is a rain or shine event- no money will be refunded for rainy days. Market advertising and associated costs have already been paid.

All vendors must follow federal, provincial and municipal health regulations, as well as farm marketing regulations e.g., Food safety, supply management regulation: milk, eggs: labeling and certification requirements (e.g., Local, Organic) related to how and where the food is produced.

Vendors it is your responsibility to represent your own products accurately. The KSFM Committee will help you out if they can.

Please keep your booth clean and take your garbage home with you. No smoking in the market area please.

The KSFM Committee (which currently is every vendor selling at the market) reserves the right to limit the number or type of vendor.

We hope to create a fair opportunity and enjoyable experience for vendors and customers alike by the above policies.
